1) Improve governance and dialogue

We need the right people around one table. And clear guidance on next steps.

2) Keep analysing MRLVC

What benefits could it deliver compared to today, how do we unlock those?

3) Understand wider risks

Focus on BBZ forecast & SDAC performance issues. Quantify concerns.

4) Prioritise solutions for the island of Ireland

Remembering no cross-zonal capacity is currently available in day-ahead.

5) A healthy dose of pragmatism

Flexibility is going to be key.
