Pan-European Bidding Zone Review consultative group (BZR CG)

- Participants: closed group of representatives based on general ('MESC-like') criteria, such as 'regional interest / pan European focus' etc. Max 25 representatives to keep it manageable.
- Extensive and open interaction on the pan-EU studies (for indicators of market liquidity & transaction costs; and transition costs)
- Updates on the progress of the simulations
- 3 to 5 meetings till the end of the BZR process

Public webinars

- Participants: anybody who is interested can sign up
- Combined workshops with one part PAN EU and next part regional specificities.
- 4 Webinars + 1 formal consultation:
- ➤ Before the start: LMPs results, explain BZR process
- ➢ In the beginning: to present input and assumptions
- ➢In the middle of the process: general update around the public consultation
- ►In the end: to present final results

ENTSO-E website
