Proactive communication towards market participants


'Level playing field' initiative

- JAO currently offers the publication of market data on its website and within its publication tools.
- To enhance the equal basis for all market participants, JAO intends to publish historical market result analyses, comparing the average day-ahead price spread to the historical long-term auction price per border for the given market period prior to upcoming long-term auctions.
- The analysis border per border may give insight into market opportunities for market participants
- The main goal is thus to increase the market competition by **improving transparency and creating a level playing field between market participants.**

Next steps / Timeline

- Publish first report before the annual auctions for the year 2023 (ie October 2022)
- As of 2023 publish reports on a monthly basis, prior to monthly auctions

Improving the Single Allocation Platform's 'users-group'

- JAO and the TSOs are working on **setting up different user's groups**, such as a **consultative user group with market participant associations**, an operational and technical user group dealing with feedback and requests on the SAP tasks and IT interfaces.
- The **existing users' group** objective is to gather feedback and requests from system users and to create awareness of future evolutions of the system, provide information to stakeholders and receive constructive feedback. It is more focused on the day-to-day activity of JAO's explicit auctioning business.
- The main aim of **creating additional users' groups** is to **create groups with different areas of expertise and focus**, such as a **consultative group**, dealing with high-level topics and expectations of market participants, which may go beyond the operational aspects of explicit auctions. Such a group should include representatives of market participant associations.
- An amendment in the "SAP Proposal" (FCA Article 49) is expected to further complement the scope of the user's group already defined in the methodology.

Next steps / Timeline

- **Gather feedback and ideas from market participant associations on the creation of such a consultative group and if appropriate, initiate the first meetings.**
- **If positive, meetings could be organized quarterly depending on need, in either a virtual and/or physical format.**
