

All TSOs Decisions – Written Voting Procedure on the scenario definition and scenario description for the year 2022 for CGM creation

Date: 07 July 2021

Procedure: via written voting procedure

Approved decisions

- All TSOs approve the "All TSOs' scenario definition and scenario description for the year 2022 CGM creation (in accordance with Article 65 of the Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/1485 of 2 August 2017 establishing a guideline on electricity transmission system operation" report, subject to final proposed corrections and consistency check.
- All TSOs ask ENTSO-E Secretariat to publish the abovementioned report on the ENTSO-E website by latest 15 July 2021.

The proposal takes into account the TSOs from the European Union Member States (EU MSs) bound by the SO GL Regulation is as follows:

- **28** of the EU MSs TSOs bound by the SO GL Regulation cast their vote (out of **38** TSOs in total).

The participation requirement provided in the SO GL Regulation for the proposal is therefore complied with, however the noted "absences" have had a negative impact on the majorities achievement.

In addition, **6** TSOs from non-EU countries, members of ENTSO-E, cast their vote.

Voting results - Majorities

- 22** EU TSOs votes were casted in favour of the decision;
- 0** EU TSOs votes were casted as abstention;
- 0** EU TSOs votes were casted against the decision;
- 5** non-EU TSOs votes were casted in favour of the decision;
- 1** non-EU TSOs abstained
- 0** non-EU TSOs votes were casted against the decision;

10 EU TSOs did not cast their votes or cast them after the deadline

In order for the decision to be adopted, unanimity should be the first goal. Alternatively, an approval by a qualified majority is necessary in accordance with the All TSOs Voting Process and the SO GL Regulation (55% of first part of voting power, i.e. number of Member States, and 65% of second part, i.e. Member States' population).

The majority requirement was reached as follows:

- formal voting 71,33 % of first part of voting powers and 89,49 % of second part;
- informal voting 69,19 % for the first part and 78,56 % of the second part of the voting powers.

The above decision has therefore been approved by **ALL TSOs on 07 July 2021.**
