1. Clean Energy Package update – State of play

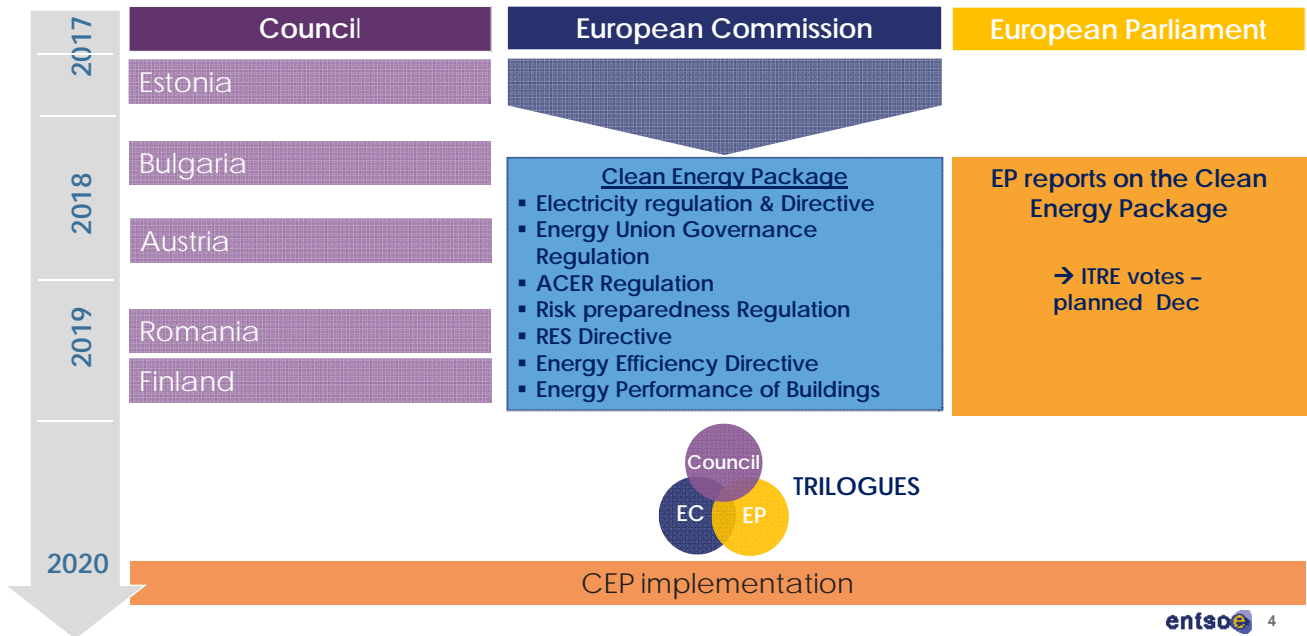
European Parliament:

- Two main views on ROCs:
 - 1: pro-ROC; strong ACER
 - 2: pro Regional Security Coordination; moderate ACER
- MEPs tabled all amendments mid-September
- Ongoing ENTSO-E advocacy on the EP amendments
- Vote in ITRE Committee December

Member States:

- Estonian Presidency had a first review of the proposals
- Member states largely favour RSC+ model, equivalent to Karins's RCC model
- More balanced TSO-DSO cooperation
- Estonian Presidency considers MS views until 12 October
- ENTSO-E review of Presidency proposals ongoing

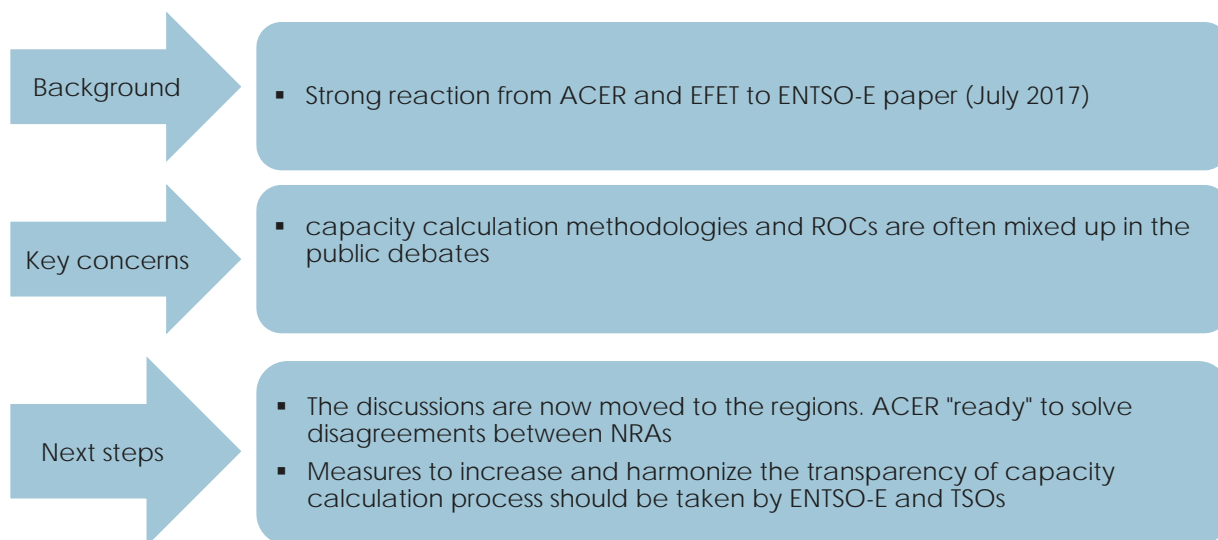
1. Clean Energy Package update – Overview 2017-2019



2. Regional Energy Forum Paper

- The REF Paper is a part of Clean Energy Package advocacy and aims respond to the critics on the regional cooperation and the need for ROCs
- The REF Paper is an update of the 2016 ENTSO-E paper "*Power Regions for the Energy Union*" approved by the Assembly
- A framework for non-mandatory regional cooperation for Member States, regulators, TSOs and stakeholders to coordinate member state responsibilities
- The publication externally will be 18th of October, with a supporting event

3. Capacity Calculation letter to ACER



3. Principals for capacity allocation

- " Increased cross-zonal capacities increase security of supply and European welfare
- European TSOs invest in domestic and cross-border capacity when socioeconomically beneficial
- European TSOs shall ensure security of supply while offering cross-zonal capacities to the market
- Cross-zonal capacities shall be set in a non-discriminatory manner, while maintaining security of the system, resulting in both internal and external customers being treated equally
- European TSOs use countertrade or redispatch, to increase cross zonal capacities, if socioeconomically beneficial and without negative impacts on system security
- NRAs shall monitor the capacity calculation process and ensure that European regulations are followed in all Member States "
